

Warner Avenue Technology Plan – The Big Picture

Missed the technology town hall meeting?

Read below to catch up on our technology plan and see what you can do to make it happen!

Abbreviated Version

1. Technology is part of a 21st Century education. We believe that Warner graduates should enter middle school with the experience and knowledge they need to succeed. We must improve our current technology curriculum.
2. In Phase I of our 3 year Technology plan, we would like to buy 4 charging carts and 120 Chromebook computers to circulate among the 3rd-5th grade classrooms. We would like to do this NOW (like next week).
3. If we are able to do this, the lower grades will double their instructional time with the iPad testing carts. The Chromebook carts would be available to our 3rd-5th grade classes in support of state testing readiness.
4. The cost of a Chromebook is approximately \$300 (we must purchase them through LAUSD to get the technical support and factory installed educational apps). LAUSD purchases additional apps throughout the year, and these too would be loaded and managed by the Information Technology Department (ITD) with no expense to Warner Avenue.
5. For Phase I we need to raise \$40,000 and we are asking \$235 from each family.
6. We can purchase Chromebooks tomorrow if we have the finances.
